2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of James McNeese, M.D. of Oak Park, who 4 passed away on August 28, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Dr. James McNeese was born in Shawnee, Oklahoma on January 1, 1925 to James W. and Florence (nee Hunter) McNeese; he worked in various levels of medicine before completing his Doctor of Medicine from the University of Puerto Rico School of Medicine in 1965; he interned in Texas and completed his residency in dermatology at John H. Stroger, Jr. Hospital of Cook County; and

WHEREAS, Dr. James McNeese settled in Oak Park in 1969 and began his private practice in La Grange; he was a member of the American Academy of Dermatology; he married Mona Leininger in 1976; and

WHEREAS, Dr. James McNeese continued to be a student, eventually working his way through many volumes of the Great Courses program; he loved liberal and progressive politics; he worked for the Democratic Party and headed the Portland, Oregon "Young Democrats" during the Kennedy campaign of 1960; his "handshake photo" with then-candidate Kennedy was a prized possession; he was also an avid chess player, writer, dreamer,
