2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Resolution 142 by replacing
3	everything after the heading with the following:
4	"WHEREAS, In late 2013, Target Corporation experienced a
5	security data breach that affected as many as 40 million people
6	who used their credit or debit cards at the retailer; and
7	WHEREAS, According to Verizon's 2014 Data Breach
8	Investigations Report, financial institutions experienced 465
9	security incidents with confirmed data loss in 2013; and
1 0	MUEDEAC According to Manifesta 2014 Date Ducado
10	WHEREAS, According to Verizon's 2014 Data Breach
11	Investigations Report, retailers experienced 148 security
12	incidents with confirmed data loss in 2013; and
13	WHEREAS, In 2014, credit card data security breaches were

reported by at least 13 nationwide retailers; and

- WHEREAS, In 2014, TotalBank in Florida reported a security 1 2 breach that put the accounts of at least 72,000 customers at
- 3 risk of personal data exposure; and
- WHEREAS, On January 27, 2015, United States Representative 4 Gus Bilarikis of Florida stated in the United States House 5 Subcommittee on Commerce, Manufacturing, and Trade that a need 6 7 exists to ensure that merchants are appropriately protecting 8 consumers; and
- WHEREAS, The Credit Union National Association has created 9 10 a national action alert regarding data breaches, including a 11 website, StoptheDataBreaches.com; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Credit Union National Association urges 13 citizens t.o make their government officials and representatives aware of the problem of data breaches; 14 15 therefore, be it
- 16 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL 17 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the United States government to focus on increased accountability and 18 higher security regarding credit data used at retailers and 19 20 financial institutions and personal information data kept by 21 any organization; and be it further

- RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be 1
- 2 presented to the members of the Illinois congressional
- delegation.". 3
