WHEREAS, Walter Veile learned the baking profession as an apprentice in his uncle's bakery and later worked as a baker and pastry chef in Germany, Switzerland, and Austria; he immigrated to the United States in 1957 and settled in the Chicago area, working in several bakeries; he then served in the United States Army for 2 years; he married Verena Lauener of Switzerland in 1971 and they moved to Lake Bluff shortly thereafter; and
