## SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Winn C. Davidson of Palatine, who passed 4 away on November 22, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Winn Davidson was born in Kansas City, Missouri on June 8, 1938 to Harry S. and Myrtle (nee Johnson) Davidson; he graduated from McHenry High School in 1956 and went on to attend the University of Illinois at Chicago and Northwestern University, where he earned his bachelor's degree in business; he lettered in wrestling at both universities; in 1967, while working at the First National Bank of Chicago, he graduated from John Marshall Law School; he married Linda Leshuk on December 26, 1979 in Woodstock; and

WHEREAS, Winn Davidson practiced law in Palatine; in 1975, he founded the Bank of Palatine, serving as President and Chairman of the Board for 39 years; and

WHEREAS, Winn Davidson served the community in many ways; he was the President of the Palatine Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Palatine Police Pension Board, a member of the Palatine Jaycees, and an honorary member of the Rotary Club of Palatine; he was recognized by John Marshall Law School with a Distinguished Service Award in 1987; throughout his career, he
