7 made their home in the Dundee area for the past 39 years; and

WHEREAS, Lee Barrett was a professional registered  
9 engineer with extensive experience in mechanical and  
10 electrical engineering; he was the President, owner, and  
11 operator of Barrett Engineering, Inc. in East Dundee; and

WHEREAS, Lee Barrett served his country as a member of the  
13 United States Army's Tank Corps and 82nd Airborne Division; and

WHEREAS, Lee Barrett was a member of AMVETS Post #202; he  
15 was a proud and loyal member of the Republican Party, an active  
16 part of Kane County politics, and a former member of the Kane  
17 County Board in District 21; he was a Precinct Committeeman for  
18 many years and a member and former officer of the Dundee  
19 Township Republican Central Committee; he was also a member of  
20 the Wicker Park Lutheran Church in Chicago; and
