WHEREAS, Patrick Condon was born in Joliet to John R. and Cecile (nee Bannon) Condon on May 30, 1925; he graduated from St. Raymond Grade School, and Joliet Catholic High School in 1943; he attended Joliet Junior College, where he was the Junior College National Leading Scorer for basketball 1944-1945; he served as an Ensign aboard the aircraft carrier LSM-176 assigned to the Asiatic-Pacific Theater during World War II; he graduated from the University of Notre Dame with a Bachelor of Science in Naval Sciences in 1947 and from Marquette University with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration in 1950; he married Norma J. Steinke on January 26, 1952; and
