AN ACT concerning carnivals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
changing Section 11-54.1-2 as follows:

б (65 ILCS 5/11-54.1-2) (from Ch. 24, par. 11-54.1-2) Sec. 11-54.1-2. No carnival shall be set up, run, 7 8 operated or conducted within the limits of a city, village or incorporated town unless a written permit from the corporate 9 authorities has been issued, setting forth the conditions 10 under which such carnival shall be operated. An application 11 12 for a written permit to set up, run, operate, or conduct a carnival in accordance with this Section shall include 13 without limitation the name, date of birth, and social 14 security number of the applicant and each employee or 15 16 subcontractor that the applicant, at the time of the application, expects to be on site for the carnival. The 17 corporate authorities shall provide a copy of the permit 18 application to the local law enforcement agency. The permit 19 20 shall be granted upon the condition that there shall not be set up or operated any gambling device, lottery, number or 21 22 paddle wheel, number board, punch board, or other game of chance, or any lewd, lascivious or indecent 23 show or attraction making an indecent exposure of the person or 24 25 suggesting lewdness or immorality.

27 Section 10. The Carnival Regulation Act is amended by 28 changing Section 2 as follows:

1 Sec. 2. No carnival shall be set up, run, operated or 2 conducted except within the limits of an incorporated municipality, as provided in Division 54.1 of Article 11 of 3 4 the "Illinois Municipal Code", approved May 29, 1961, as heretofore and hereafter amended, or within the limits or 5 upon the grounds of a State or county fair association, or 6 7 any association entitled to share in the funds appropriated by the State for distribution among fair associations of the 8 9 State, and unless a written permit from the proper fair board has been issued, setting forth the conditions under which 10 11 such carnival shall be operated. An application for a written 12 permit to set up, run, operate, or conduct a carnival in accordance with this Section shall include without limitation 13 the name, date of birth, and social security number of the 14 applicant and each employee or subcontractor that the 15 16 applicant, at the time of the application, expects to to be on site for the carnival. The fair board shall provide a copy 17 of the permit application to the local law enforcement 18 agency. The permit shall be granted upon the condition that 19 20 there shall not be set up or operated any gambling device, 21 lottery, number or paddle wheel, number board, punch board, 22 or other game of chance, or any lewd, lascivious or indecent 23 show or attraction making an indecent exposure of the person or suggesting lewdness or immorality. 24
