AN ACT concerning taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Telecommunications Municipal 5 Infrastructure Maintenance Fee Act is amended by changing 6 Section 15 as follows:

7 (35 ILCS 635/15)

8 Sec. 15. State telecommunications infrastructure9 maintenance fees.

10 (a) A State infrastructure maintenance fee is hereby
11 imposed upon telecommunications retailers as a replacement
12 for the personal property tax in an amount specified in
13 subsection (b).

(b) The amount of the State infrastructure maintenance 14 15 fee imposed upon a telecommunications retailer under this 16 Section shall be equal to 0.5% of all gross charges charged by the telecommunications retailer to service addresses in 17 State for telecommunications, other than wireless 18 this telecommunications, originating or received in this State. 19 20 However, the State infrastructure maintenance fee is not imposed in any case in which the imposition of the fee would 21 22 violate the Constitution or statutes of the United States.

(c) An optional infrastructure maintenance fee is hereby 23 A telecommunications retailer may elect to pay the 24 created. optional infrastructure maintenance fee with respect to the 25 gross charges charged by the telecommunications retailer to 26 27 service addresses in a particular municipality for telecommunications, other than wireless telecommunications, 28 29 originating or received in the municipality if (1) the telecommunications retailer is not required to pay any 30 compensation to the municipality under an existing franchise 31

1 agreement and (2) the municipality has not imposed а 2 municipal infrastructure maintenance fee as authorized in Section 20 of this Act. A telecommunications 3 retailer 4 electing to pay the optional infrastructure maintenance fee 5 shall notify the Department of such election on the 6 application for certificate of registration. If а 7 telecommunications retailer elects to pay this fee with 8 respect to the gross charges charged by the 9 telecommunications retailer to service addresses in a particular municipality, such election shall remain in full 10 11 force and effect until such time as the municipality imposes a municipal infrastructure maintenance fee. 12

of optional 13 (d) The amount the infrastructure maintenance fee which a telecommunications retailer may elect 14 to pay with respect to a particular municipality shall be 15 16 equal to 25% of the maximum amount of the municipal infrastructure maintenance fee which the municipality could 17 impose under Section 20 of this Act. 18

(e) The State infrastructure maintenance fee and the
optional infrastructure maintenance fee authorized by this
Section shall be collected, enforced, and administered as set
forth in subsection (b) of Section 25 of this Act.

23 (f) A telecommunications retailer that pays the optional infrastructure maintenance fee with respect to the gross 24 25 charges charged by the telecommunications retailer to service 26 addresses in a particular municipality for telecommunications, other than wireless communications, 27 originating or received in the municipality shall annually 28 verify with that municipality all service addresses located 29 in that municipality. For each service address that is not 30 located in a municipality and therefore not eligible to be 31 32 charged the optional infrastructure maintenance fee, the telecommunications retailer shall issue a refund to the 33 34 customer of all amounts improperly charged for the optional

2	1/2% per month or portion thereof from the date the fee was
3	improperly collected to the date the refund is issued.
