- 1 AN ACT in regard to vehicles.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 3. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5.545 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/5.545 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5.545. The Lions of Illinois Fund.</u>
- 8 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 9 adding Section 3-648 as follows:
- 10 (625 ILCS 5/3-648 new)
- 11 Sec. 3-648. Lions of Illinois license plates.
- 12 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
- 13 <u>Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and</u>
- 14 <u>applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of</u>
- 15 State, may issue Lions of Illinois license plates to
- 16 <u>residents of Illinois who meet eligibility requirements</u>
- 17 prescribed by the Secretary of State. The special Lions of
- 18 <u>Illinois plate issued under this Section shall be affixed</u>
- 19 <u>only to passenger vehicles of the first division and motor</u>
- vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000
- 21 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire
- 22 <u>according to the staggered multi-year procedure established</u>
- by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
- 24 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be
- 25 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State,
- 26 <u>except that the International Association of Lions Clubs</u>
- 27 <u>emblem shall appear at the lower right corner of the plate,</u>
- 28 and immediately to the left of the emblem shall appear the
- 29 <u>following words: "Lions of Illinois". The Secretary may, in</u>

- 1 <u>his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as</u>
- 2 <u>vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section</u>
- 3 <u>3-405.1</u> of this Code. The plates are not required to
- 4 <u>designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b)</u>
- of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe
- 6 the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion,
- 7 shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided
- 8 <u>under Section 3-412.</u>
- 9 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged
- 10 <u>a \$40 fee for original issuance in addition to the</u>
- 11 appropriate registration fee. Of this fee, \$25 shall be
- deposited into the Lions of Illinois Fund and \$15 shall be
- 13 <u>deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate</u>
- 14 Fund, to be used by the Secretary to help defray the
- 15 <u>administrative processing costs.</u>
- 16 For each registration renewal period, a \$27 fee, in
- 17 <u>addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be</u>
- 18 <u>charged. Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the Lions</u>
- of Illinois Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary
- of State Special License Plate Fund.
- 21 (d) The Lions of Illinois Fund is created as a special
- 22 <u>fund in the State treasury</u>. All moneys in the Lions of
- 23 <u>Illinois Fund shall be paid, subject to appropriation by the</u>
- 24 General Assembly and approval by the Secretary, as grants to
- 25 <u>the Lions of Illinois Endowment Fund.</u>
