- 5 Section 5. The Department of Commerce and Community

- 9 Sec. 605-450. Community economic emergencies.
- 10 (a) Upon the recommendation of the Director, the
- 11 Governor may find that an economic emergency exists in a
- designated Illinois community. The finding shall be based on
- one or more of the following conditions:
- 14 (1) There has been a relocation or closing of
- operations of a major private employer in the community.
- 16 (2) There has been a closing or relocation of a
- major public employer in the community.
- 18 (3) A natural disaster has resulted in substantial
- damage to the local economy.
- 20 (4) The community or a portion of it has been
- declared a disaster area by the federal government.
- 22 (5) A decision by the federal or State government
- or by a foreign government has done substantial damage to
- the local economy.
- 25 <u>(6) A high level of poverty or unemployment is</u>
- 26 <u>chronic in the community. For the purposes of this item</u>
- 27 (6), a community is deemed to have a high level of
- 28 <u>poverty if the percentage of its residents who have</u>
- incomes below the federal poverty level is equal to or
- 30 greater than the percentage of residents of the City of
- 31 <u>East St. Louis who have incomes below the federal poverty</u>

level. For the purposes of this item (6), a community is

2 <u>deemed to have chronic unemployment if its average</u>

3 <u>unemployment rate for the 3 previous calendar years is</u>

for the 3 previous calendar years in the City of East St.

6 Louis.

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- 7 (b) Upon a finding by the Governor that an economic 8 emergency exists in a designated Illinois community, the 9 Governor shall convene an Economic Emergency Council. Council shall consist of 11 members as follows: the Director 10 11 of Commerce and Community Affairs, ex officio, the Director of the Illinois Development Finance Authority, ex officio, 12 the Director of the Illinois Housing Development Authority, 13 ex officio, and 8 members representing the designated 14 community appointed by the Governor with the advice and 15 16 consent of the Senate. Of the 8 members appointed by the Governor, 4 shall be representatives of business and finance, 17 shall be representatives of labor, and 2 shall be 18 representatives of education. Each member of the General 19 20 Assembly whose legislative district or representative district lies in whole or in part within the designated 21 community shall also be a member of the Council, ex officio. 22 23 Members of a Council shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for their reasonable and necessary expenses 24 25 incurred in the performance of their duties.
- (c) An Economic Emergency Council shall develop a plan 26 to address the designated community's economic needs and 27 shall recommend that plan to the Governor and to the General 28 29 Assembly for further resolution and appropriation. The plan 30 may include extending enterprise zone tax incentives, making 31 economic development business loans and grants, making 32 infrastructure rehabilitation loans and grants, extending job training and retraining assistance, extending tax increment 33 34 financing, and other appropriate economic programs

- 1 incentives.
- 2 (d) The Illinois Economic Emergency Assistance Fund is
- 3 created as a special fund in the State treasury for the
- 4 purpose of channeling moneys to designated communities upon
- 5 further resolution and appropriation by the General
- 6 Assembly. In addition to amounts that may be appropriated to
- 7 the fund, gifts or grants from any legal source may be
- 8 deposited into the fund. Any fees or other charges collected
- 9 by the Department in connection with programs under this
- 10 Section shall also be deposited into the fund.
