- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Recreational Trails of Illinois Act is
- 5 amended by changing Section 45 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 862/45)
- 7 Sec. 45. Public access sticker.
- 8 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), after January
- 9 1, 1998, a person may not operate and an owner may not give
- 10 permission to another to operate an off-highway vehicle on
- land or lands or waters in public off-highway vehicle parks
- 12 paid for, operated, or supported by the grant program
- 13 established under subsection (d) of Section 15 unless the
- 14 off-highway vehicle displays an off-highway vehicle public
- 15 access sticker in a manner prescribed by the Department by
- 16 rule.
- 17 (b) An off-highway vehicle does not need a public access
- 18 sticker if the off-highway vehicle is used on private land or
- if the off-highway vehicle is owned by the State, the federal
- 20 government, or a unit of local government.
- 21 (c) The Department shall issue the public access
- 22 stickers and shall charge the following fees:
- 23 (1) \$30 for 3 years for individuals.
- 24 (2) \$50 for 3 years for rental units.
- 25 (3) \$75 for 3 years for dealer and manufacturer
- demonstrations and research.
- 27 (4) \$50 for 3 years for an all-terrain vehicle or
- off-highway motorcycle used for production agriculture,
- as defined in Section 3-821 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
- 30 (5) \$50 for 3 years for residents of a State other
- 31 than Illinois that does not have a reciprocal agreement

- with the Department, pursuant to subsection (d).
- 2 (6) \$50 for 3 years for an all-terrain vehicle or
- 3 off-highway motorcycle that does not have a title.
- 4 The Department, by administrative rule, may make replacement
- 5 stickers available at a reduced cost. These fees for public
- 6 access stickers shall be deposited into the Off-Highway
- 7 Vehicle Trails Fund.
- 8 (d) The Department is authorized to enter into
- 9 reciprocal agreements with other states that have a similar
- 10 off-highway vehicle public access sticker program to allow
- 11 residents of such states to operate off-highway vehicles on
- land or lands or waters in public off-highway vehicle parks
- 13 paid for, operated, or supported by the grant program
- 14 established under subsection (d) of Section 15 without
- 15 acquiring an off-highway vehicle public access sticker in
- 16 this State pursuant to subsection (a).
- 17 (e) The Department may license vendors to sell
- 18 off-highway vehicle public access stickers. Issuing fees may
- 19 be set by administrative rule.
- 20 (f) Any person participating in an organized competitive
- 21 <u>event on land or lands in off-highway vehicle parks paid for,</u>
- 22 <u>operated by, or supported by the grant program established in</u>
- 23 <u>subsection</u> (d) of <u>Section 15 shall display the public access</u>
- 24 <u>sticker required under subsection (c) of this Section or pay</u>
- 25 \$5 per event. Fees collected under this subsection shall be
- deposited into the Fund.
- 27 (q)(f) The Department is authorized to modify any or all
- 28 provisions of this Section 45 by rule.
