- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- Facility Planning Area Rules Act. 5
- Section 5. Definitions. For the purposes of this Act: 6
- "Facility planning area" means an area as defined in 7
- 8 paragraph 2.33 of the Illinois Water Quality Management Plan.
- "Resource protection plan" is any plan adopted by a 9
- public agency that includes goals, policies, strategies, and 10
- procedures for preserving key farmland, natural areas, 11
- 12 cultural resources, or aquatic resources.
- 13 Section 10. Rules. Within one year of the enactment of
- 14 this Act, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency shall
- 15 propose rules that set forth procedures for Agency approval
- of facility planning area amendments that provide that the 16

- 18 (a) approve amendments only when they:
- 19 (1) are consistent with (i) the provisions of
- the Illinois Water Quality Management Plan and its 20

- urban runoff, and hydrographic modification; (ii) 24
