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AN ACT concerning gas storage.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Gas Storage Act is amended by changing
Section 1 as follows:

6 (220 ILCS 15/1) (from Ch. 96 1/2, par. 5501)

Sec. 1. Any corporation which is engaged in or desires to 7 8 engage in, the distribution, transportation or storage of natural gas or manufactured gas, which gas, in whole or in 9 part, is intended for ultimate distribution to the public in 10 State of Illinois, if the said business of such 11 the corporation is regulated or subject to regulation under 12 13 either the laws of the State of Illinois or the laws of the United States, shall have the right to enter upon, take or 14 15 damage private property or any interest therein, in the 16 manner provided for by the law of eminent domain, necessary or convenient for its said operations, including the storage 17 of gas, all of which operations are hereby recognized and 18 19 declared to be affected with a public interest and all of the 20 property used in which operations is hereby recognized and declared to be devoted to public use. If a person (i) holds a 21 22 certificate of public convenience and necessity issued under 23 the federal Natural Gas Act (that is, under 15 U.S.C. 717f) 24 for the construction of a pipeline for the transportation of natural gas and (ii) desires to exercise the right of eminent 25 domain as authorized in that Act, then the person must 26 27 exercise that right in a proceeding under Article VII of the 28 Code of Civil Procedure in the circuit court of the county in which the property to be acquired is located. 29
