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AN ACT concerning pharmaceutical assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons
Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act is
amended by changing Section 3.15 as follows:

8 Sec. 3.15. "Covered prescription drug" means (1) any cardiovascular agent or drug; (2) any insulin or other 9 used in the treatment of diabetes, 10 prescription drug including syringe and needles used to administer the insulin; 11 (3) any prescription drug used in the treatment of arthritis, 12 13 (4) beginning on January 1, 2001, any prescription drug used in the treatment of cancer, (5) beginning on January 1, 2001, 14 15 any prescription drug used in the treatment of Alzheimer's 16 disease, (6) beginning on January 1, 2001, any prescription drug used in the treatment of Parkinson's disease, (7) 17 18 beginning on January 1, 2001, any prescription drug used in 19 the treatment of glaucoma, and (8) beginning on January 1, 20 2001, any prescription drug used in the treatment of lung disease and smoking related illnesses, and (9) beginning on 21 22 January 1, 2002, any prescription drug used in the treatment 23 of epilepsy and its secondary conditions and side effects. The specific agents or products to be included under such 24 categories shall be listed in a handbook to be prepared and 25 distributed by the Department. The general types of covered 26 27 prescription drugs shall be indicated by rule. The Department Public Health shall promulgate a list of covered 28 of 29 prescription drugs under this program that meet the definition of a narrow therapeutic index drug as described in 30 subsection (f) of Section 4. 31
