- 1 AN ACT concerning transportation.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Department of Transportation Law of the
- 5 Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by changing
- 6 Section 2705-505 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 2705/2705-505) (was 20 ILCS 2705/49.30)
- 8 Sec. 2705-505. Signs indicating travel-related
- 9 facilities or tourist-oriented businesses. The Department
- 10 shall, where economically feasible and safe, install along
- 11 various interstate highways and other freeways with full
- 12 control of access, except those that are toll highways, signs
- 13 to alert motorists of the travel-related facilities available
- 14 in communities served by upcoming interstate exits. The
- 15 Department may also install, along other rural State
- 16 highways, signs to alert motorists of the tourist-oriented
- 17 businesses available on intersecting highways and roads under
- 18 local jurisdiction in rural areas. The Department has the
- 19 authority to sell or lease space on the signs to the owners
- 20 or operators of the facilities and to promulgate rules and
- 21 regulations for the leasing or purchasing of space.
- 22 The Department may contract for the operation and
- 23 <u>administration of the program required by this Section in</u>
- 24 <u>accordance</u> with the Illinois Procurement Code. A contractor
- 25 <u>under this Section must provide marketing, installation,</u>
- 26 <u>maintenance</u>, and replacement of signs. A contract may
- 27 provide for a flat fee or a percentage of revenues for the
- 28 State. A contract must retain for the Department approval of
- 29 <u>sign locations, marketing fees, and maximum fee charges.</u>
