- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Dental Practice Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 5 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 20/5) (from Ch. 111, par. 6355)
- 7 Sec. 5. Powers and duties of the Department.
- 8 1. The Department $\underline{\text{must}}$ shall exercise the powers and
- 9 duties as set forth in this Act.
- 10 2. The Director <u>must</u> shall promulgate rules consistent
- 11 with the provisions of this Act for the administration and
- 12 enforcement thereof, and shall prescribe forms which must
- shall be issued in connection therewith.
- 3. In addition, the Department <u>must</u> shall:
- 15 (a) Establish rules for determining approved
- 16 undergraduate and graduate social work degree programs and
- 17 prepare and maintain a list of colleges and universities
- 18 offering such approved programs whose graduates, if they
- 19 otherwise meet the requirements of this Act, are eligible to

- 21 (b) Promulgate rules, as may be necessary, for the
