- 4 Section 5. The Professional Boxing and Wrestling Act is
- 5 amended by changing Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 105/10) (from Ch. 111, par. 5010)
- 7 Sec. 10. Who must be licensed. In order to participate
- 8 in boxing contests the following persons must each be
- 9 licensed and in good standing with the Department: (a)
- 10 promoters, (b) contestants, (c) seconds, (d) referees, (e)
- judges, (f) managers, (g) matchmakers, and (h) timekeepers.
- 12 Announcers may participate in boxing contests without
- 13 being licensed under this Act. It shall be the

- 15 comply with this the Act, and all rules and regulations
