AN ACT concerning conservation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Rivers, Lakes, and Streams Act is amended
by changing Section 5 as follows:

6 (615 ILCS 5/5) (from Ch. 19, par. 52)

5. <u>Jurisdiction.</u> The Department of Natural 7 Sec. Resources shall upon behalf of the State of Illinois, have 8 jurisdiction and supervision over all of the rivers and lakes 9 of the State of Illinois, wherein the State of Illinois or 10 the people of the State have any rights or interests, and 11 shall make a list by counties of all the waters of Illinois, 12 13 showing the waters, both navigable and non-navigable, that are found in each county of the State, and if the same are 14 lakes, the extent of the shore lines and the amount, extent 15 16 and area of the water surface; and in a like way, if the same are rivers, and specifying whether the same are navigable or 17 non-navigable, and whether they have or have not been 18 19 meandered.
