AN ACT concerning emergency telephone services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Emergency Telephone System Act is amended
by changing Section 2.16 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 750/2.16)

Sec. 2.16. Private business switch service. "Private 7 8 business switch service" means a telecommunications service including centrex type service and private branch exchange 9 service (PBX), even though key telephone 10 systems or equivalent telephone systems registered with the FCC under 47 11 C.F.R. Part 68 are directly connected to centrex type and PBX 12 13 systems providing 9-1-1 services equipped for switched local network connections or 9-1-1 system access to business end 14 15 users through a private telephone switch. The term "private 16 business switch service" does not include key telephone systems or equivalent telephone systems registered with the 17 18 FCC under 47 C.F.R. Part 68 when not used in conjunction with centrex type and PBX systems. "Private business switch 19 service" typically includes, but is not limited to, private 20 corporations, and industries where 21 businesses, the 22 telecommunications service is primarily for conducting business. <u>"Private business switch service" does not include</u> 23 school and religious buildings. 24
