- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Department of Human Services Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 10-30 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 1305/10-30 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 10-30. Refugee and immigrant services; grants.</u>
- 8 <u>(a) The Department shall establish a grant program</u>
- 9 <u>designed to assist not-for-profit community organizations</u>
- 10 that serve refugees and immigrants. Subject to
- 11 appropriations, the program shall make grants to those
- organizations to enable them to do any of the following:
- 13 <u>(1) Purchase or build buildings or office space for</u>
- their organizational and community programs.
- 15 (2) Renovate property that the organization leases
- or owns and that it uses to provide services to refugees
- 17 <u>and immigrants.</u>
- 18 (b) A grant under this Section may not exceed \$100,000.
- 19 <u>To be eligible for a grant, an organization must provide</u>
- 20 <u>additional funding in an amount equal to 50% of the amount of</u>
- 21 the grant.
- 22 (c) If an organization receives a grant under this
- 23 <u>Section to purchase, build, or renovate property, and if the</u>
