AN ACT concerning emergency telephone services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Emergency Telephone System Act is amended
by changing Section 10.1 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 750/10.1) (from Ch. 134, par. 40.1)

7 Sec. 10.1. <u>Confidentiality</u>.

(a) 9-1-1 information consisting of names, addresses and 8 telephone numbers of telephone customers whose listings are 9 published in directories or listed in Directory 10 not Assistance Offices is confidential. Except as provided in 11 subsection (b), information shall be provided on a 12 call-by-call basis only for the purpose of responding to 13 14 emergency calls.

15 (b) 9-1-1 information, including information described 16 in subsection (a), may be used by a public safety agency for 17 the purpose of placing out-going emergency calls.

18 (c) Any public safety agency that uses 9-1-1 information 19 for the purposes of subsection (b) must establish methods and 20 procedures that ensure the confidentiality of information as 21 required by subsection (a).

22 (d) Divulging confidential information in violation of
 23 this Section is a Class A misdemeanor.
