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AN ACT concerning public funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Public Funds Statement Publication Act
is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 15/1) (from Ch. 102, par. 5)

Sec. 1. Except as provided in Section 2.1, each public 7 8 officer, other than a state officer, (and other than a city or village treasurer or municipal officer who is required by 9 Article 3 of the Illinois Municipal Code, approved May 10 29, 1961, as heretofore and hereafter amended, to file an annual 11 report to the city council or board of trustees which report 12 13 is required to be published, and other than a treasurer of a city, village or incorporated town, who is required to file 14 15 an account with the municipal clerk, which account is published as required by "An Act in relation to the 16 preparation, publication and filing of annual accounts of 17 18 certain municipalities, the payment of tax monies to treasurers of certain municipalities, and providing penalties 19 for violations thereof", approved August 15, 20 1961, as heretofore and hereafter amended), who, by virtue of his 21 22 office receives for disbursement and disburses public funds in the discharge of governmental or municipal debts and 23 liabilities, shall, at the expiration of each fiscal year, 24 prepare a statement: 25

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(1) Of all moneys received and from what sources received, giving items, particulars and details;

1 whom paid and the amount paid to each person; 2 (3) Of all monies paid out as compensation for personal services, giving the name of each individual to 3 4 whom paid and the total amount paid to each person, except that any public officer may elect to report the 5 compensation for personal services of all personnel by 6 name, listing each employee in one of the following 7 8 categories: 9 (A) under $\frac{$25,000.00}{$15,000}$; (B) <u>\$25,000.00</u> \$15,000 to <u>\$49,999.99</u> \$24,999; 10 11 (C) <u>\$50,000.00</u> \$25,000 to <u>\$74,999.99</u> \$39,999; 12 θf (D) <u>\$75,000.00 to \$99,999.99</u> \$40,000-and-over; 13 14 and (E) \$100,000.00 to \$124,999.99; or 15 16 (F) \$125,000.00 and over; and (4) A summary statement of operations for all funds 17 and account groups, as excerpted from the annual 18 financial report as filed with the appropriate State 19 agency of the State of Illinois. 20 21 Such statement shall be subscribed and sworn to by the public officer making such statement, and, within 6 months 22 23 after the expiration of such fiscal year shall be filed in the office of the county clerk of the county in which such 24 25 public officer resides. 27 Section 10. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by 28 changing Section 3.1-35-65 as follows:

29 (65 ILCS 5/3.1-35-65) (from Ch. 24, par. 3.1-35-65)
 30 Sec. 3.1-35-65. Treasurer; annual accounts.

31 (a) Within 6 months after the end of each fiscal year,32 the treasurer of each municipality having a population of

less than 500,000, as determined by the last preceding federal census, shall annually prepare and file with the clerk of the municipality an account of moneys received and expenditures incurred during the preceding fiscal year as specified in this Section. The treasurer shall show in the account:

7 (1) All moneys received by the municipality, 8 indicating the total amounts, in the aggregate, received 9 in each account of the municipality, with a general statement concerning the source of receipts. In this 10 11 paragraph, the term "account" does not mean each individual taxpayer, householder, licensee, utility user, 12 13 or other persons whose payments to the municipality are credited to a general account. 14

15 (2) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this 16 subsection (a), all moneys paid out by the municipality 17 where the total amount paid during the fiscal year 18 exceeds \$2,500 in the aggregate, giving the name of each 19 person to whom moneys were paid and the total paid to 20 each person.

(3) All moneys paid out by the municipality as compensation for personal services, giving the name of each person to whom moneys were paid and the total amount paid to each person from each account, except that the treasurer may elect to report the compensation for personal services of all personnel by name, listing each employee in one of the following categories:

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(4) A summary statement of operations for all funds

and account groups of the municipality, as excerpted from
 the annual financial report as filed with the appropriate
 State agency.

4 (b) Upon receipt of the account from the municipal 5 treasurer, the municipal clerk shall publish the account at 6 least once in one or more newspapers published in the 7 municipality or, if no newspaper is published in the municipality, then in one or more newspapers having a general 8 circulation within the municipality. In municipalities with a 9 10 population of less than 500 in which no newspaper is published, however, publication may be made by posting a copy 11 of the account in 3 prominent places within the municipality. 12 (Source: P.A. 89-63, eff. 6-30-95.) 13
