- Sec. 4.5. Employee drug testing; report.
- 8 (a) A child care facility shall test each of its
- 9 <u>employees for illegal drugs at the time their licenses are</u>
- 10 <u>issued or renewed</u>. The cost of an employee's drug test under
- 11 this Section shall be paid by the child care facility that
- 12 <u>employs him or her. The administration of drug tests</u>
- 13 required under this Section is a condition of child care
- 14 <u>facility license issuance or renewal under this Act.</u>
- 15 (b) In addition to the drug tests required under
- 16 <u>subsection (a), the Department shall institute a pilot</u>
- 17 program whereby it shall conduct random, unannounced drug
- 18 tests of a representative sample of persons subject to drug
- 19 <u>tests under subsection (a).</u>
- 20 <u>(c) The Illinois Department of Children and Family</u>
- 21 <u>Services shall report the results of testing required under</u>
