- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by

- 20 (c) Every such prohibited sign, signal or marking is

- 5 (f-1) This Section does not prohibit a municipality from

- 10 (2) The sign or banner is of a size no greater than
- 11 <u>30 square feet.</u>
- 12 <u>(3) The sign or banner does not obstruct or</u>
