AN ACT concerning the Illinois commemorative quarter.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
Illinois Commemorative Quarter Act.

6 Section 5. Purpose. Under the State Quarters Program, 7 the United States Mint is to issue a quarter in 2003 with an 8 Illinois design to adorn the reverse side. The Governor is 9 in charge of officially selecting the design. This Act 10 governs which design is selected.

Selection of design. The Governor shall 11 Section 10. 12 submit 5 design concepts to the United States Mint. After the United States Mint has created the designs and returned 13 them to the State for the final selection process, the State 14 15 Board of Education shall implement a voting system in which all students in this State in kindergarten through 12th grade 16 17 are given the opportunity to vote to choose which of the 5 designs is to be the final design officially selected by the 18 19 Governor. The Governor shall officially select as the final design whichever design receives the most votes and shall 20 submit this design to the United States Secretary of the 21 Treasury for final endorsement. 22

23 Section 90. Rules. The State Board of Education may 24 adopt any rules necessary to carry out its responsibilities 25 under this Act.

26 Section 95. Repealer. This Act is repealed on January 27 1, 2004.

- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 1
- 2 becoming law.
