AN ACT making appropriations.
```

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much 5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects б 7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent 8 expenses of the Office of the Lieutenant Governor: 9 GENERAL OFFICE 10 For Personal Services ..... \$ 1,408,000 11 For Employee Retirement Contributions 12 Paid by Employer ..... 13 56,000 14 For State Contributions to State Employees' Retirement System ..... 15 141,000 16 For State Contributions to 17 Social Security ..... 107,000 For Contractual Services ..... 520,000 18 For Travel ..... 19 86,000 20 For Commodities ..... 27,500 21 For Printing ..... 27,500 9,000 22 For Equipment ..... 23 For Electronic Data Processing ..... 60,000 For Telecommunications Services ..... 24 82,500 For Operational and Grant Expenses of the 25 Rural Affairs Council ..... 307,000 26 27 Total \$2,831,500 28 The amount of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 29 the Office of the Lieutenant Governor for the ordinary and 30 contingent expenses of the Illinois River Coordination 31 Council. 32

1 Section 2. The sum of \$110,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Agricultural 3 Premium Fund to the Office of Lieutenant Governor for all 4 costs associated with the Rural Affairs Council including any 5 grants or administration expenses.

6 Section 3. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may 7 be necessary, is appropriated from the Lieutenant Governor's 8 Grant Fund to the Office of Lieutenant Governor to be 9 expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon 10 which such funds were received and in the exercise of the 11 powers or performance of the duties of the Office of the 12 Lieutenant Governor.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on 14 July 1, 2001.
