

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
8 General Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent
9 expenses of the Office of the Lieutenant Governor:

28 The amount of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may be
29 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
30 the Office of the Lieutenant Governor for the ordinary and
31 contingent expenses of the Illinois River Coordination
32 Council.

1 Section 2. The sum of \$110,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Agricultural
3 Premium Fund to the Office of Lieutenant Governor for all
4 costs associated with the Rural Affairs Council including any
5 grants or administration expenses.

6 Section 3. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
7 be necessary, is appropriated from the Lieutenant Governor's
8 Grant Fund to the Office of Lieutenant Governor to be
9 expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon
10 which such funds were received and in the exercise of the
11 powers or performance of the duties of the Office of the
12 Lieutenant Governor.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on
14 July 1, 2001.
