AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much 6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the 8 General Revenue Fund to the Industrial Commission:

11 Section 2. In addition to the amounts heretofore 12 appropriated, the following named amount, or so much thereof 13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 14 Fund to the Industrial Commission for the project hereinafter 15 enumerated:

Section 3. The amount of \$121,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Industrial Commission for printing and distribution of Workers' Compensation handbooks containing information as to the rights and obligations of employers.

Section 4. The amount of \$271,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Industrial Commission for the implementation and operation of an accident reporting system.
