1 counties other than Cook County, 2 managers of Illinois 2 municipalities, 3 chiefs of municipal police departments in Illinois having no Superintendent of the Police Department on 3 4 the Board and 2 citizens of Illinois who shall be members of 5 an organized enforcement officers' association which has no 6 other members on the Board other than the chief of a 7 municipal police department, the Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Director of State Police, a 8 9 county sheriff or deputy sheriff. The appointments of the Governor shall be made on the first Monday of August in 1965 10 11 with 3 of the appointments to be for a period of one year, 3 for 2 years, and 3 for 3 years. Their successors shall be 12 appointed in like manner for terms to expire the first Monday 13 of August each 3 years thereafter. All members shall serve 14 until their respective successors are appointed and qualify. 15 16 Vacancies shall be filled by the Governor for the unexpired 17
