AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3017
 AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend House Bill 3017 by replacing
 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

8 Sec. 605-705. Grants to local tourism and convention 9 bureaus.

10 (a) To establish a grant program for local tourism and 11 convention bureaus. The Department will develop and implement a program for the use of funds, as authorized under 12 this Act, by local tourism and convention bureaus. For the 13 14 purposes of this Act, bureaus eligible to receive funds are those local tourism and convention bureaus that are (i) 15 local government or incorporated as 16 either units of 17 not-for-profit organizations; (ii) in legal existence for a minimum of 2 years before July 1, 2001; (iii) operating with 18 19 a paid, full-time staff whose sole purpose is to promote tourism in the designated service area; and (iv) affiliated 20 21 with one or more municipalities or counties that support the 22 bureau with local hotel-motel taxes. After July 1, 2001,

1 bureaus requesting certification in order to receive funds 2 for the first time must be local tourism and convention bureaus that are (i) either units of local government or 3 4 incorporated as not-for-profit organizations; (ii) in legal 5 existence for a minimum of 2 years before the request for 6 certification; (iii) operating with a paid, full-time staff 7 whose sole purpose is to promote tourism in the designated 8 service area; and (iv) affiliated with multiple 9 municipalities or counties that support the bureau with local hotel-motel taxes. Each bureau receiving funds under this Act 10 11 will be certified by the Department as the designated recipient to serve an area of the State. Notwithstanding the 12 13 criteria set forth in this subsection (a), or any rule adopted under this subsection (a), the Director of the 14 15 Department may provide for the award of grant funds to one or 16 more entities if in the Department's judgment that action is 17 necessary in order to prevent a loss of funding critical to promoting tourism in a designated geographic area of the 18 19 <u>State.</u>

To distribute grants to local tourism and convention 20 (b) 21 bureaus from appropriations made from the Local Tourism Fund 22 for that purpose. Of the amounts appropriated annually to 23 the Department for expenditure under this Section, one-third those monies shall be used for grants to convention and 24 of 25 tourism bureaus in cities with a population greater than 26 500,000. The remaining two-thirds of the annual appropriation shall be used for grants to convention and 27 tourism bureaus in the remainder of the State, in accordance 28 29 with a formula based upon the population served. The 30 Department may reserve up to 10% of the total appropriated to conduct audits of grants, to provide incentive funds to those 31 32 bureaus that will conduct promotional activities designed to 33 further the Department's statewide advertising campaign, to 34 fund special statewide promotional activities, and to fund
