- (a) Every application for any permit or license 9
- authorized to be issued under this Act shall be made upon a 10
- form furnished by the Secretary of State. Every application 11

The 8 9 Secretary of State may, in his discretion, by rule or regulation, provide that an application for a drivers license 10 11 or permit may include a suitable photograph of the applicant in the form prescribed by the Secretary, and he may further 12 provide that each drivers license shall include a photograph 13 of the driver. The Secretary of State may utilize 14 15 photograph process or system most suitable to deter 16 alteration or improper reproduction of a drivers license and to prevent substitution of another photo thereon. 17

- (c) The application form shall include a notice to the applicant of the registration obligations of sex offenders under the Sex Offender Registration Act. The notice shall be provided in a form and manner prescribed by the Secretary of State. For purposes of this subsection (c), "sex offender" has the meaning ascribed to it in Section 2 of the Sex Offender Registration Act.
