- 7 (625 ILCS 5/6-105) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 6-105)
- 8 Sec. 6-105. Instruction permits and temporary licenses
- 9 for persons 18 years of age or older.
- 10 (a) Except as provided in this Section, the Secretary of
- 11 State upon receiving proper application and payment of the
- 12 required fee may issue an instruction permit to any person 18
- 13 years of age or older who is not ineligible for a license
- under paragraphs 1, 3, 4, 5, 7, or 8 of Section 6-103, after
- 15 the applicant has successfully passed such examination as the
- 16 Secretary of State in his discretion may prescribe.
- 1. An instruction permit entitles the holder while
- having the permit in his immediate possession to drive a
- 19 motor vehicle, excluding a motor driven cycle or
- 20 motorcycle, upon the highways for a period of 12 months
- 21 after the date of its issuance when accompanied by a
- licensed driver who is 21 years of age or older, who has

had a valid driver's license classification to operate such vehicle for at least one year and has had one year of driving experience with such classification and who is occupying a seat beside the driver.

- 2. A 12 month instruction permit for a motor driven cycle or motorcycle may be issued to a person 18 years of age or more, and entitles the holder to drive upon the highways during daylight under the direct supervision of a licensed motor driven cycle operator or motorcycle operator with the same or greater classification, who is 21 years of age or older and who has at least one year of driving experience.

- 15 (c) The Secretary of State may issue a temporary
 16 driver's license to an applicant <u>making an application</u> for a
 17 license permitting the operation of a motor vehicle <u>for one</u>
 18 <u>of the following reasons:</u>
 - (1) The applicant is applying for a non-photo driver's license for religious reasons or as a result of facial disfigurement and is waiting for that application to be processed.
 - (2) The applicant is prohibited by bona fide religious convictions from applying for a social security number, has made application for a driver's license using a distinctive number in lieu of a social security number, and is waiting for that application to be processed.
 - (3) There is a mechanical failure at the facility that makes the issuance of a driver's license impossible.
 - (4) while---the---Secretary---is---completing----an investigation--and-determination-of-all-facts-relative-to such-applicant's-eligibility-to-receive-such-license,--or for Any other reason prescribed by rule or regulation promulgated by the Secretary of State.

- 1 Such permit must be in the applicant's immediate
- 2 possession while operating a motor vehicle, and it shall be
- 3 invalid when the applicant's driver's license has been issued
- 4 or for good cause has been refused. In each case the
- 5 Secretary of State may issue the temporary driver's license
- 6 for such period as appropriate but in no event for longer
- 7 than 90 days. The Secretary shall adopt the rules necessary
- 8 <u>to implement this subsection (c).</u>

- 13 (a) Every application for any permit or license
- 14 authorized to be issued under this Act shall be made upon a
- 15 form furnished by the Secretary of State. Every application
- shall be accompanied by the proper fee and payment of such
- 17 fee shall entitle the applicant to not more than 3 attempts
- 18 to pass the examination within a period of 1 year after the
- 19 date of application.
- 20 (b) Every application shall state the name, social
- 21 security number, zip code, date of birth, sex, and residence
- 22 address of the applicant; briefly describe the applicant;
- 23 state whether the applicant has theretofore been licensed as
- 24 a driver, and, if so, when and by what state or country, and
- 25 whether any such license has ever been cancelled, suspended,
- 26 revoked or refused, and, if so, the date and reason for such
- 27 cancellation, suspension, revocation or refusal; shall
- include an affirmation by the applicant that all information
- 29 set forth is true and correct; and shall bear the applicant's
- 30 signature. The application form may also require the
- 31 statement of such additional relevant information as the
- 32 Secretary of State shall deem necessary to determine the
- 33 applicant's competency and eligibility. The Secretary of

1 State may in his discretion substitute a federal individual 2 tax identification number in lieu of a social security number, or he may instead assign an additional distinctive 3 4 number in lieu thereof, where an applicant is prohibited by bona fide religious convictions from applying or is exempt 5 б from applying for a social security number, where the applicant, upon proof from the Social Security 7 8 Administration, is ineligible to receive a social security 9 number, or where the applicant presents a federal individual tax identification number; such information shall not be 10 11 shared with other governmental agencies or sold to marketing entities or companies. The Secretary of State shall, however, 12 determine which religious orders or sects have such bona fide 13 religious convictions. The Secretary of State may, in his 14 15 discretion, by rule or regulation, provide 16 application for a drivers license or permit may include a suitable photograph of the applicant in the form prescribed 17 by the Secretary, and he may further provide that each 18 19 drivers license shall include a photograph of the driver. The Secretary of State may utilize a photograph process or system 20 21 most suitable to deter alteration or improper reproduction of 22 a drivers license and to prevent substitution of another 23 photo thereon. (c) The application form shall include a notice to the 24 applicant of the registration obligations of sex offenders

applicant of the registration obligations of sex offenders
under the Sex Offender Registration Act. The notice shall be
provided in a form and manner prescribed by the Secretary of
State. For purposes of this subsection (c), "sex offender"
has the meaning ascribed to it in Section 2 of the Sex
Offender Registration Act.
