AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by 5 changing Section 24-3.4 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/24-3.4) (from Ch. 38, par. 24-3.4)
7 Sec. 24-3.4. Unlawful sale of firearms by liquor
8 licensee.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person who holds a 9 license to sell at retail any alcoholic liquor issued by the 10 Illinois Liquor Control Commission or local liquor control 11 commissioner under the Liquor Control Act of 1934 or an agent 12 13 or employee of the licensee to sell or deliver to any other person a firearm in or on the real property of the 14 establishment where the licensee is licensed to 15 sell 16 alcoholic liquors unless the licensed seller is primarily engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property 17 at retail and the sale or delivery of the firearm is 18 otherwise lawful under this Article and under the Firearm 19 Owners Identification Card Act. 20

(b) Sentence. A violation of subsection (a) of thisSection is a Class 4 felony.
