AN ACT concerning the regulation of professions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Private Detective, Private Alarm, Private
Security, and Locksmith Act of 1993 is amended by changing
Section 10 as follows:

7 (225 ILCS 446/10)

8 Sec. 10. Legislative intent. The intent of the General 9 Assembly in enacting this statute is to regulate persons and 10 businesses licensed under this Act for the protection of the 11 public. These practices are <u>found</u> declared to be practices 12 affecting the public health, safety, and welfare and subject 13 to State regulation. This Act shall be construed to best 14 carry out these purposes.
