AN ACT concerning public graveyards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Public Graveyards Act is amended by5 changing Section 2c as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 610/2c) (from Ch. 21, par. 14c)

7 Sec. 2c. <u>Use of township funds.</u>

(a) The board of trustees of 8 any township may appropriate funds from the township treasury to be used for 9 the purpose of putting any old, neglected graves 10 and cemeteries controlled, managed, and owned by the township in 11 a cleaner and more respectable condition. The--amount--so 12 13 appropriated--shall--not--exceed,-in-any-one-year,-the-sum-of 14 \$300,-unless-a-larger--sum--is--authorized--by--the--township electors-at-an-annual-or-special-town-meeting. 15

16 (b) The board of trustees of any township may 17 appropriate funds from the township treasury to be used for 18 the maintenance of a non-profit cemetery or a cemetery owned 19 by the State or another unit of local government.
