- 4 Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 285-10 as follows:
- 6 (60 ILCS 1/285-10)
- 7 Sec. 285-10. Use of moneys. Moneys paid to the township
- 8 supervisor under Section 285-5, may be appropriated and
- 9 expended for defraying the general charges and expenses of
- 10 the township; for laying out, making, and repairing the roads
- 11 and bridges of the township and <u>for</u> purchasing materials,
- implements, and machinery for those undertakings; and for the
- 13 payment of any outstanding orders, all in the manner and
- 14 proportions the legal voters of the township determine at
- 15 their annual township meeting or special township meeting
- 16 duly called for that purpose.
