Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Silent Reflection Act is amended by 5 changing Section 0.01 and adding Section 5 as follows:

Sec. 0.01. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
Silent Reflection and Student Prayer Act.

Sec. 5. Student prayer. In order that the right of every 11 12 student to the free exercise of religion is guaranteed within 13 the public schools and that each student has the freedom to not be subject to pressure from the State either to engage in 14 15 or to refrain from religious observation on public school grounds, students in the public schools may voluntarily 16 engage in individually initiated, non-disruptive prayer that, 17 consistent with the Free Exercise and Establishment Clauses 18 of the United States and Illinois Constitutions, is not 19 sponsored, promoted, or endorsed in any manner by the school 20 21 or any school employee.
