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AN ACT in relation to the transfer of real property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 1. The Director of the Department of Natural 4 Resources, on behalf of the State of Illinois, is authorized 5 to Convey and Quit Claim unto the City of Granite City, an 6 7 Illinois unit of local government, its successors and assigns, for and in consideration of \$1.00 paid to said 8 9 Department, a non-exclusive, unobstructed, perpetual easement for the purpose of constructing, installing, or laying, and 10 thereafter 11 using, operating, inspecting, repairing, maintaining, and replacing a storm water ditch or sewer on, 12 13 over, under, and across all or part of the following 14 described real property, subject to such conditions as may be deemed necessary by said Department to protect the public 15 interest, to wit: 16

17 An 80-foot wide tract of land being 40 feet wide on 18 either side of a centerline located in the West Half of 19 Section 15, Township 3 North, Range 9 West of the Third 20 Principal Meridian, Madison County, Illinois, said 21 centerline being more fully described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northwest 22 23 Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 15; along the East line of said Northwest 24 thence North Northwest Quarter of Section 15, a 25 Quarter of the distance of 574.2 feet to a point on the southeasterly 26 right-of-way line of the former Nickel Plate Railroad; 27 28 thence Southwesterly along said right-of-way line, a distance of 69.04 feet to a point on the centerline of a 29 30 tract of land conveyed to the Alton and Southern Railroad Company by deed recorded in Book 550, Page 167 31 in the records of Madison County, Illinois, and being 32

the Point of Beginning of the centerline being described; thence South along the centerline of said tract conveyed to the Alton and Southern Railroad Company, a distance of 2700 feet, more or less, to a point on the Northerly shoreline of Horseshoe Lake, being the Termination Point of the centerline being described;

7 Said 80-foot wide tract being bounded on the North
8 by the Southeasterly right-of-way line of the former
9 Nickel Plate Railroad, and on the South by the Northerly
10 shoreline of Horseshoe Lake.

11 Section 900. The Director of Natural Resources shall obtain a certified copy of the portions of this 12 Act containing the title, enacting clause, the effective date, 13 the appropriate Section or Sections containing the land 14 15 descriptions of the property to be transferred or otherwise affected, and this Section within 60 days after its effective 16 17 date and, upon receipt of the payment required by the Section or Sections, if any payment is required, shall record the 18 certified document in the Recorder's Office in the county in 19 20 which the land is located.

Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effectiveupon becoming law.

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
