AN ACT concerning disaster service volunteers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Disaster Service Volunteer Leave Act is
amended by changing Section 3 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 335/3) (from Ch. 127, par. 4053)

Sec. 3. Disaster Service Volunteer Leave. 7 An employee 8 of a State agency who is a certified disaster service volunteer of the American Red Cross or assigned to the 9 10 Illinois Emergency Management Agency in accordance with the Illinois Emergency Management Act, the Emergency Management 11 Assistance Compact Act, or other applicable administrative 12 13 rules may be granted leave from his work with pay for not more than 20 working days in any 12-month period to 14 15 participate in specialized disaster relief services for the 16 American Red Cross or for the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, as the case may be, upon the request of the American 17 18 Red Cross or the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the 19 services of that employee and upon the approval of that 20 employee's agency, without loss of seniority, pay, vacation time, compensatory time, personal days, sick time or earned 21 22 overtime accumulation. The agency shall compensate an employee granted leave under this Section at his regular rate 23 of pay for those regular work hours during which the employee 24 is absent from his work. Leave under this Act shall not be 25 26 unreasonably denied be-granted-only-for-services-related-to-a 27 disaster-occurring-within-the-State-of-Illinois.

Section 10. The Local Government Disaster Service
Volunteer Act is amended by changing Section 15 as follows:

2 15. Local government disaster service volunteer Sec. leave. An employee of a local agency who is a certified 3 4 disaster service volunteer of the American Red Cross or 5 assigned to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency in accordance with the Illinois Emergency Management Act, the 6 7 Emergency Management Assistance Compact Act, or other 8 applicable administrative rules may be granted leave from his 9 or her work with pay for not more than 20 working days in any 12-month period to participate in specialized disaster relief 10 services for the American Red Cross or for the Illinois 11 12 Emergency Management Agency, as the case may be, upon the request of the American Red Cross or the Illinois Emergency 13 Management Agency for the services of that employee and upon 14 15 the approval of that employee's agency, without loss of 16 seniority, pay, vacation time, compensatory time, personal days, sick time, or earned overtime accumulation. The agency 17 18 must compensate an employee granted leave under this Section 19 at his or her regular rate of pay for those regular work hours during which the employee is absent from work. Leave 20 under this Act shall not be unreasonably denied may-be 21 granted-only-for-services-related--to--a--disaster--occurring 22 23 within-the-State-of-Illinois.
