- 4 Section 5. The Disaster Service Volunteer Leave Act is

- 7 Sec. 3. Disaster Service Volunteer Leave. An employee
- 8 of a State agency who is a certified disaster service

- 11 <u>Illinois Emergency Management Act, the Emergency Management</u>

- 20 employee's agency, without loss of seniority, pay, vacation

- 13 disaster service volunteer of the American Red Cross or
- 14 <u>assigned to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency in</u>

- 16 <u>Emergency Management Assistance Compact Act, or other</u>
