- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 356h as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/356h) (from Ch. 73, par. 968h)
- 7 Sec. 356h. <u>Adopted children</u>. No individual or group
- 8 policy of accident and health insurance which covers the
- 9 insured's immediate family or children, as well as covering
- 10 the insured, shall exclude a child from coverage or limit
- 11 coverage for a child solely because the child is an adopted
- 12 child, or solely because the child does not reside with the
- insured. For purposes of this Section, a child who is in the
- 14 custody of the insured, pursuant to an interim court order of
- 15 adoption or, in the case of group insurance, placement of
- 16 adoption, whichever comes first, vesting temporary care of
- the child in the insured, is an adopted child, regardless of
- 18 whether a final order granting adoption is ultimately issued.
