AN ACT concerning freedom of information.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Freedom of Information Act is amended by5 changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 140/10) (from Ch. 116, par. 210)

7 Sec. 10. <u>Denial of requests; appeal.</u>

(a) Any person denied access to inspect or copy any 8 public record may appeal the denial by sending a written 9 notice of appeal to the head of the public body. 10 Upon receipt of such notice the head of the public body shall 11 promptly review the public record, determine whether under 12 13 the provisions of this Act such record is open to inspection 14 and copying, and notify the person making the appeal of such determination within 7 working days after the notice of 15 appeal. 16

(b) Any person making a request for public records shall be deemed to have exhausted his administrative remedies with respect to such request if the head of the public body affirms the denial or fails to act within the time limit provided in subsection (a) of this Section.
