AN ACT with regard to highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Toll Highway Act is amended by changing
Section 3.1 as follows:

6 (605 ILCS 10/3.1) (from Ch. 121, par. 100-3.1)

There is created an advisory committee Sec. 3.1. 7 composed of 7 members of the House of Representatives 8 appointed by the Speaker thereof, 7 members of the Senate 9 appointed by the President, and 15 members appointed by the 10 Governor. It is the intention of this section that the 11 Governor's appointments shall be made with due consideration 12 13 to the location of proposed toll highway routes so that maximum geographic representation from the areas served by 14 said toll highway routes may be accomplished insofar as 15 16 practicable. The members shall be appointed during the month of June and shall serve from the first day in July in 17 odd-numbered years for a two-year period and until their 18 successors are appointed and qualified, except that General 19 20 Assembly members shall serve such term or until termination legislative service, whichever first occurs. 21 of their 22 Appointments shall be in writing and filed with the Secretary of State as a public record. Vacancies shall be filled in the 23 same manner as original appointments. The committee shall 24 choose from among its members a chairman and secretary. It 25 26 may meet on call of the chairman or any 6 members. The 27 members shall receive no compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of their 28 29 duties.

30 The committee shall meet with the Illinois State Toll 31 Highway Authority and shall advise it on all matters relating

- 1 to policy and the administration of the toll highway system.
