AN ACT in relation to elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing
Section 21-3 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/21-3) (from Ch. 46, par. 21-3)

Sec. 21-3. Publication of results. Within 5 five days 7 after the votes shall have been canvassed and the results 8 declared or the result declared by lot as provided for in 9 Section 21-2 above, the Governor shall cause the result of 10 the said election to be published, and shall proclaim the 11 persons electors of President and Vice-President so chosen 12 composing the list so elected, by transmitting by mail to the 13 several persons so chosen and composing the list or set 14 elected, electors of President 15 and Vice-President 16 certificates in triplicate, under the Seal of State of their appointment, and shall also transmit under the Seal of State 17 to the Secretary of State of the United States the 18 certificate of the election of said electors as required by 19 20 the laws of Congress.
