- 1 AN ACT regarding vehicles.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 3-609 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-609) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-609)
- 7 Sec. 3-609. Disabled Veterans' Plates. Any disabled
- 8 veteran who has been or declared eligible for funds for the
- 9 purchase of a motor vehicle of the first division or for a
- 10 motor vehicle of the second division weighing not more than
- 11 8,000 pounds by the United States Federal Government because
- 12 of his or her disability, may make application for the
- 13 registration of one such vehicle, to the Secretary of State
- 14 without the payment of any registration fee. Registration
- shall be for a multi-year period effective in 1980 and may be
- issued staggered registration.
- 17 Any disabled veteran of World War I, of World War II, of
- the National Emergency between June 25, 1950 and January 31,
- 19 1955 or of the period beginning February 1, 1955 and ending
- 20 on the day before the first day thereafter in which
- 21 individuals (other than individuals liable for induction by
- 22 reason of prior deferment) are no longer liable for induction
- 23 for training and service into the armed forces under the

- 7 and such registration plates may not be issued to any person
- 8 not eligible therefor.
- 9 The Illinois Veterans Commission may assist in providing
- 10 the documentation of disability.
