- 3 line 27, after "purposes", by inserting the following:

- 6 causes to improvements lawfully located in the right-of-way.
- 7 Owners of abutting property whose descriptions include the
- 8 right-of-way but are made subject to the right-of-way shall
- 9 <u>be entitled to compensation for use of the right-of-way</u>"; and
- 10 on page 10, line 12, after "road.", by inserting the
- 11 following:
- 12 "For purposes of the preceding sentence, property that
- includes a portion of a highway or road but is subject to the
- 14 <u>highway or road shall not be considered to end at the highway</u>
- 15 <u>or road.</u>"; and
- on page 10, line 19, after "consent.", by inserting the
- 17 following:
- 18 "This provision is not intended to absolve a utility from
- 19 <u>obtaining consent from a lawful owner of the roadway or</u>
- 20 <u>highway property (i.e. a person whose deed of conveyance</u>
- 21 <u>lawfully includes the property, whether or not made subject</u>
- 22 <u>to the highway or road) but who does not pay taxes by reason</u>
- of Division 6 of Article 10 of the Property Tax Code. "; and

- on page 11, line 28, after "property being conveyed", by
- 2 inserting the following:
- 3 "or expressly states that the road, street, highway, or alley
- 4 <u>is excepted from the property being conveyed. A conveyance</u>
- 5 <u>does not expressly exclude a road, street, highway, or alley</u>
- 6 <u>if the conveyance is described</u> as <u>being "subject to" the</u>
- 7 road, street, highway, or alley. The rights accruing in the
- 8 abutting property owner under this Act shall be subject to
- 9 <u>all existing uses and easements located within the</u>
- 10 <u>right-of-way; the rights shall also be subject to such future</u>
- 11 <u>uses and easements as may be permitted to be located within</u>
- 12 <u>the right-of-way under the provisions of the Illinois Highway</u>
- 13 <u>Code or any successor statute thereto</u>".
