- 8 (a) A person commits the offense of criminal trespass to
- 9 <u>a nuclear facility if he or she knowingly and without lawful</u>

- 11 (1) enters or remains within a nuclear facility or
- on the grounds of a nuclear facility, after receiving
- notice before entry that entry to the nuclear facility is

- 15 (2) remains within the facility or on the grounds
- of the facility after receiving notice from the owner
- or manager of the facility or other person authorized by
- 18 <u>the owner or manager of the facility to give that notice</u>
