1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5803

AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend House Bill 5803, AS AMENDED, by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following:

5 "Section 5. The Auction License Act is amended by6 changing Section 10-1 as follows:

8 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2010)
9 Sec. 10-1. Necessity of license; exemptions.

10 (a) It is unlawful for any person, corporation, limited 11 liability company, partnership, or other entity to conduct an 12 auction, provide an auction service, hold himself or herself 13 out as an auctioneer, or advertise his or her services as an 14 auctioneer in the State of Illinois without a license issued 15 by OBRE under this Act, except at:

16 (1) an auction conducted solely by or for a
 17 not-for-profit organization for charitable purposes;

18 (2) an auction conducted by the owner of the19 property, real or personal;

20 (3) an auction for the sale or lease of real
21 property conducted by a licensee under the Real Estate
22 License Act, or its successor Acts, in accordance with

the terms of that Act; and

2 (4) an auction conducted by a business registered 3 as a market agency under the federal Packers and 4 Stockyards Act (7 U.S.C. 181 et seq.) or under the 5 Livestock Auction Market Law<u>;</u>.

(5) an auction conducted by an agent, officer, or employee of a federal agency in the conduct of his or her official duties; and

9 <u>(6) an auction conducted by an agent, officer, or</u> 10 <u>employee of the State government or any political</u> 11 <u>subdivision thereof performing his or her official</u> 12 <u>duties.</u>

(b) Nothing in this Act shall be construed to apply to a 13 new or used vehicle dealer or a vehicle auctioneer licensed 14 by the Secretary of State of Illinois, or to any employee of 15 16 the licensee, who is a resident of the State of Illinois, while the employee is acting in the regular scope of his or 17 her employment for the licensee while conducting an auction 18 19 that is not open to the public, provided that only new or used vehicle dealers licensed by the Secretary of State or 20 licensed by another jurisdiction may buy property at the 21 22 auction 7-or-to-sales-by-or-through-the-licensee.

(c) Nothing in this Act shall be construed to prohibit a person under the age of 18 from selling property under \$250 in value while under the direct supervision of a licensed auctioneer.
