1 AN ACT concerning higher education student assistance.

- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Higher Education Student Assistance Act
- is amended by adding Section 65.56 as follows:
- 6 (110 ILCS 947/65.56 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 65.56. Ryan Loan Repayment for Teachers Program.</u>
- 8 (a) In order to encourage academically talented Illinois
- 9 <u>students to enter and continue teaching in Illinois schools</u>
- in low-income areas, the Commission shall, each year, receive
- 11 and consider applications for loan repayment assistance under
- 12 this Section. This program shall be known as the Ryan Loan
- 13 Repayment for Teachers Program. The Commission shall
- 14 <u>administer the program and shall make all necessary and</u>
- 15 proper rules not inconsistent with this Section for the
- 16 <u>program's effective implementation.</u>
- 17 <u>(b) Subject to a separate appropriation made for such</u>
- 18 purposes, the Commission shall award a grant to each
- 19 qualified applicant in an amount equal to the amount of
- 20 <u>educational loans forgiven on behalf of the qualified</u>
- 21 <u>applicant pursuant to Sections 424 and 425 of Title IV of the</u>
- 22 <u>Higher Education Amendments of 1998 (20 U.S.C. 1078-10 and</u>
- 23 <u>1078-11</u>). The Commission shall encourage the recipient of a
- 24 grant under this Section to use the grant amount awarded to
- 25 pay off his or her educational loans.
- 26 <u>(c) A person is a qualified applicant under this Section</u>
- 27 <u>if he or she meets all of the following qualifications:</u>
- 28 <u>(1) The person is a United States citizen or</u>
- 29 <u>eligible noncitizen.</u>
- 30 (2) The person is a resident of this State.
