- SECTION 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF 13
- EDUCATION CHIEF-STATE-EDUCATIONAL-OFFICER 14
- (a) There is created a State Board of Education to be 15 elected or selected on a regional basis. The number of 16 17 members, their qualifications, terms of office and manner of
- election or selection shall be provided by law. The Board 18
- shall advise the State Superintendent of Education concerning,--except--as--limited-by-law,-may-establish goals, 20

18 A State Superintendent of Education shall be elected in 2006 and thereafter. When the State Superintendent of 19 Education initially elected under Section 2 of Article X of 20 the Illinois Constitution takes office, the term of office of 21 22 the chief state educational officer appointed by the State Board of Education shall expire. This Constitutional 23 24 Amendment otherwise takes effect when the State Superintendent of Education initially elected under Section 2 25

of Article X of the Illinois Constitution takes office.
